

Contest for Young Scientists

For the speaker, participation in the congress is free and includes certificates:

10 points on a national scale

Certificate in International credits - 14 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits*TM

5 points on a national scale, for publication of abstracts.

The number of oral reports is limited to 6 works

The Contest for Young Scientists is an initiative of the Organising Committee of the Congress to set up to promote the ideals of co-operation and interchange between young scientists in the area of medicine particularly antibiotic resistance. The Contest is the annual summarizing of the best scientific achievements among young scientists and this gives students the opportunity to compete with the best of their contemporaries at National level.

All reports should correspond to the topics of the First International Congress "Rational use of antibiotics in the modern world. Antibiotic resistance STOP! ».

Young scientists up to 35 years can participate in this Contest.

The report should be sent via e-mail info@antibiotic-congress.com with indication "Contest for Young Scientists". The deadline of submission is **August 31, 2018**.

Required volume of the report consists of 2 and included:

full name, date of birth, position, name of organization, city, mobile phone number, e-mail to contact the author and be certified by the signature and seal of the head of the institution.

Assessment of the reports is carried out by the Jury in accordance with criteria. The Jury is composed of members of Programme Committee of the Congress. Based on the assessment of presented reports, the Jury conducts competitive selection and identifies the best scientific works. The winners are offered to present results of their researches on 16 November 2018 in the section «Reports of Young Scientists».

Basic requirements for preparing the presentation:

1. Presentation lasts no more than 10 minutes. If it lasts longer, the section moderator has the right to ask the speaker to proceed to conclusions and complete the report.
2. The presentation should be in PowerPoint format (.pptx or ppt), other formats are not accepted.
3. The number of slides should not exceed 20.
4. Information in the presentation must correspond to the submitted abstracts.
