

## Abstract preparation and submission

Abstract is a brief summary of the basic provisions of own or researches performed in co-authorship. Abstracts should present new research or developing information, and correspond to the topic of the II International Congress in Ukraine "Rational use of antibiotics. Antibiotic resistance STOP!».

### **Abstract publication is free.**

Abstracts should be sent via e-mail [info@antibiotic-congress.com](mailto:info@antibiotic-congress.com) and deadline for submission is **31 of August 2019**

**While submitting, indicate in the topic of the letter:** *abstract\_surname*

**in the text:** *all authors' full names, affiliations, e-mail addresses, country, city*

### **Abstract requirements**

1. Page Layout Guideline for A4 (21 cm x 29,7 cm) paper size. Page Layout should be as follow: Top – 2,5 cm, Bottom – 2 cm, Left – 2 cm, Right – 2 cm.
2. Maximum length for the abstract is approx. 5000 characters.
3. Abstract should be Times New Roman typeface, single-spaced.
4. Abstract is prepared in three languages: Ukrainian, Russian, English.
5. Tables or diagrams are not considered.
6. All symbols and abbreviations are deciphered at first use.
7. Abstract should include:
  - Title of the work;
  - Author/s full name/s (if participating, the name of scientific supervisor should be written lastly with indication of his/her scientific degree);
  - Name of the institution, organization, department where the work was performed
  - Text of the abstracts, according to the structure:
    - Background
    - Purpose
    - Materials and methods
    - Results of research and discussion
    - Conclusions
    - Key words

The authors are responsible for the content of the submitted materials. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to scientific and literary editing of the submitted materials and refusal to print abstracts in case of non-compliance with the abstract requirements or scientific programme of the Congress.

If the abstracts do not comply with the requirements or the scientific program of the Congress, the scientific committee may not accept them for publication.
